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Personal Health Information Protection Act (PHIPA)

LOFT Community Services is required by law to keep a record of your care while you are receiving services from us. PHIPA is the law of Ontario that sets out rules for the collection, use and disclosure of personal health information.

What health information is collected?

We collect personal health

information about you either directly from you or from the person acting on your behalf.

The information we collect may include your name, date of birth, address, health history including medications, records of your visits and the care that you received. We

will ask for your consent to receive

and collect information about you

from other health service providers.

Why is my health information used?

We use your personal health information to:

- Provide health services to you
- Make our services better
- Support our students' learning activities

How is your privacy protected?

We pledge to you that we will protect your personal health information by:

- Taking reasonable steps to protect your personal health information from theft, loss and unauthorized access, copying, modification, use, disclosure and disposal
- Taking reasonable steps to store all physical and electronic documents containing health information in a secured manner
- Conducting audits and complete investigations to monitor and manage our privacy compliance
- Ensure that everyone who performs services for us protects your privacy and only uses your personal health information for the purposes you have consented to

Who is my health information shared with?

We may share your health information with:

- Persons you choose to share with
- Other health care providers who are caring for you
- First responders when an emergency occurs

What are my rights with respect to health information?

- You have a right to review your health record with your health care provider
- You have a right to receive a copy of your health record
- You have a right to correct factual information in your personal health record (e.g.DOB, address)
- You have a right to withdraw your consent (subject to certain legal exceptions)
